parish you belong to. **Saint of the Week** to PO Box 26, Chewelah, WA 99109. Thank you for supporting your parish. Our Saint of the Week this week is St. John of Capistrano, whose memorial is October 23, and he lived during a particularly tumultuous time in both Church and European history: the late 14th and early 15th Centuries. One-third of the European population and almost forty percent of the clergy were killed by the bubonic plague; the Western Schism split the Church with two or even three claimants to the Chair of St. Peter at one time; England and France were at war; the city-states of present-day Italy were in constant conflict. Gloom dominated the spirit of the culture during this time.

Enter St. John. His education was thorough, and his talents and successes were great. He was only 26 when he was made governor of Perugia in northern Italy, but at the age of 30, he entered the Franciscan novitiate and was ordained a priest just four years later.

His preaching attracted great congregations during a time of religious apathy and confusion, and along with twelve of his Franciscan brethren, he was received all throughout Europe like angels of God in their instrumental ministry of reviving a dying faith and Catholic devotion. Later on, he helped bring about a reunion with the Greek and Armenian churches.

When the Turks captured Constantinople in 1453 and the Ottoman Empire was born, he was commissioned to preach a crusade for the defense of Europe, focusing his efforts in Hungary. He led the crusader army to Belgrade, where they gained an overwhelming victory and broke the Turkish siege on the city. Soon after the battle, however, worn out from the battle, he succumbed to infection and died on October 23, 1456.

On his tombstone, it is inscribed: “This tomb holds John, by birth of Capistrano, a man worthy of all praise, defender and promoter of the faith, guardian of the Church, zealous protector of his Order, an ornament to all the world, lover of truth and
